To celebrate Volunteers Week 2023, we arranged a lunch for our Volunteers at the Stretton Fox. Volunteers are one of the most valuable assets of our organisation and we just wanted to say, "thank you"!



Carers Week

To celebrate Carers Week, we joined forces with Warrington Disability Partnership and hosted a daily drop-in session at their Centre for Independent Living. Two local Councillors visited one of the sessions and spent time chatting to us, as well as a member of staff from Warrington Borough Council. Both Councillors are supportive of the service and one of them has linked her Facebook page to ours so that she can promote our activities.



We also launched our first ever Carers Breakfast Club as part of Carers Week. This is now a regular event and takes place on the third Tuesday of every month at the Galleries Café, Centre for Independent Living, Beaufort Street Warrington, WA5 1BA. At the Club we ran on 18th July, 5 Carers joined Rosie, one of our Carers Information and Support Officers, and all enjoyed breakfast and the time spent together.

We then spent the day at St Rocco's Hospice Warrington, where we hosted a Coffee & Chat event. Staff from Warrington Borough Council's Carer Support Team joined us, as did staff from the Macmillan Delamere Cancer Information and Support Centre. The lovely kitchen staff at St Rocco's made delicious cupcakes for us to enjoy!



Andy Carter, MP for Warrington South, visited us at our offices to meet the team and hear more about the work we do. The visit was very informal and gave us the opportunity to discuss local issues. Andy has invited Carers and staff to visit Parliament when he is sitting in session.

Wyn Higham, one of our longstanding Carers made headline news in the Warrington Guardian! She shared her story about why being a voice for unpaid Carers became her passion. For the last 33 years, Wyn has cared for her husband who suffered a brain haemorrhage, followed by a massive stroke. At the time, there was little support for Carers in Warrington, so Wyn decided to form a group with people in similar situations to herself and the first Carers Centre in Warrington was formed in the early 1990s. Wyn continues support other Carers and our service.

13th and 16th July were two very busy days for us! On the 13th, we joined United Utilities at Walton Gardens to celebrate their Customer Vulnerability Summit 2023 and our Carers Wellbeing Festival 2023. We worked together to support each other's event and it was lovely to see so many of our Carers joining us – 47 in fact! There were information stands from different organisations, including Cheshire Fire & Rescue Service. United Utilities provided a buffet lunch, after which it was time to relax with our therapists for massages, mindfulness, and therapeutic drumming. We were also joined by Councillor Paul Warburton who regularly supports our events. Paul told us he had spoken on BBC Radio Manchester the previous week and had advertised today's event – thank you Paul!

The big day finally arrived on the 16th – DAD (Disability Awareness Day) 2023! The weather was kind to us in the main, but it couldn't resist raining every now and then!

We had a successful day, with 8 new Carers asking to join our service.

Our Service Manager, Anna, was interviewed by Hospital Radio, and she enthusiastically promoted the service! We became more famous as the day went on when Warrington Radio, which broadcasts in Warrington Market, interviewed Anna and our Carers Information and Support Officer, Helen, about

the service. If you know of any other radio stations who want to know about our service, do point them in our direction!

During the day, we were visited by the Mayor of Warrington (Steve Wright), Councillor Paul Warburton and Dennis Dunn MBE JP DL, High Sheriff of Cheshire. We chatted to them and told them all about our service and our amazing Carers.

When the event ended, one of our Carers Information and Support Officers, Helen, gave our balloons to children as they were leaving, and it was a joy to see the pleasure one balloon can give to a child!



Carers Needed!

There are a number of groups meeting to support and develop the work of the Carers Strategy and one of these groups is looking for Carers to join it. State of Caring Survey 2023 now live!

This is the most comprehensive research into the experience of Carers in the UK. Carers UK use what you tell them to shape their campaigns and make sure Carers voices are heard by the government.

Last year, over 13,000 Carers shared their experiences in the survey. This helped Carers UK secure new rights for unpaid Carers with the Carer's Leave Act in England, Scotland and Wales, and also provided vital evidence to help Carers UK campaign for improvements to Carers benefits through their Carer Poverty Coalition.

But much more still needs to be done to get Carers the practical and financial support they need.

Free access to digital resources to support unpaid carers - Jointly contract extended until March 2024!

NHS England and Carers UK are giving unpaid Carers free access to digital resources. [The Digital Resource for Carers](#) is an online platform that hosts resources for Carers to help them build resilience in their caring role.

The resources can help to deliver on the [NHS Long Term Plan Commitments to unpaid carers](#) and include e-learning, guides and comprehensive signposting, access to MyBackUp, a simple contingency planning tool for what might happen in an emergency, and Jointly, Carers UK's care co-ordination app.

Carers UK have published [guidance for health professionals](#) which explains how the offer works as well as ideas and tips for how to refer Carers for support. This link explains to Carers how Jointly works: [Jointly app for carers | Carers UK](#)

Information and codes can be given to all Carers within an integrated care board (or ICB*), be they supported by Health (primary, community, acute)/Local Authorities/VCSE organisations commissioned by the Local Authority, and organisations not commissioned.

The Jointly access code for Cheshire and Merseyside is DPCN9533.

*(An ICB is a statutory NHS organisation which is responsible for developing a plan for meeting the health needs of the population, managing the NHS budget and arranging for the provision of health services in a geographical area.)

Jointly makes caring easier, less stressful and more organised by making communication and coordination between those who share the care as easy as a text message.

With Jointly, you can create a circle of care for the person you are looking after. Once you have set up your Jointly circle, you can start using Jointly to organise care.

You can use it on your own or you can invite other people to join you and share the care.

Jointly works on iPhone, iPad, Android devices and on most modern web browsers (home computers, laptops, smartphones, tablets, etc).

Social Tariffs

Did you know that you may be eligible for low-cost broadband and mobile phone tariffs? The Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport recognise that people are worried about their bills so they have been working with internet service providers to deliver low-cost broadband and phone packages called Social Tariffs.

Social Tariffs are discounted broadband and mobile deals for people on Universal Credit and other benefits. These tariffs are delivered in the same way as normal packages, just at a lower price. Amid rising living costs, they have been encouraging more broadband and mobile companies to offer Social Tariffs to help customers on low incomes.

A large number of broadband providers now offer discounted Social Tariff products, with some offering deals from as low as £15 per month. This could represent a saving of more than £180 per year, which is around 50% compared to the average cost of broadband.

If you receive government benefits, you could qualify for one of these discounted price plans.

Do you like rhubarb? Here's a really easy recipe for you to try!

Rhubarb and Yogurt Cake

Ingredients

- 150g rhubarb, finely diced
- 300g self-raising flour
- 250g caster sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract or vanilla essence
- 2 eggs
- 125g Greek yogurt at room temperature
- 125g melted unsalted butter or margarine



Recipe

- Preheat oven to 180C/350F/Gas 4.
- Grease a loaf tin or use a loaf tin liner.
- Put all the ingredients into a large bowl and mix well.
- Pour the batter into the prepared loaf tin and bake for an hour until well risen and golden brown on top.
- Turn out onto a wire rack and leave to cool completely.
